The first site I made as a professional web developer used 17 frames.

My first professional assignment was coding the World Press Photo site. In those days sites had to be compatible with Netscape and Explorer 3 and 4. That wasn't a problem - that's what I'd been hired for.

The site needed three content areas inside a static design of navigation and decoration. Nowadays we might use iframes for the content areas, but back then only one of the four popular browsers supported them. So I coded the site in frames and found that... I needed more than expected.

People were already protesting against this point of view. "Keep It Simple, Stupid!", they said. Of course other people disagreed. One mail succinctly stated: "KISS leads to LOVE (Leave Out Virtually Everything)".

This reaction accurately mirrored my fears. If we'd leave out the newest technologies, the well-designed Flash movie, the nifty DHTML script, what kind of site would remain? Just text and the tiniest bit of HTML? *Booooring.*

But then I discovered two things.

First of all sites should be exciting only when their purpose is to be exciting. An entertainment site

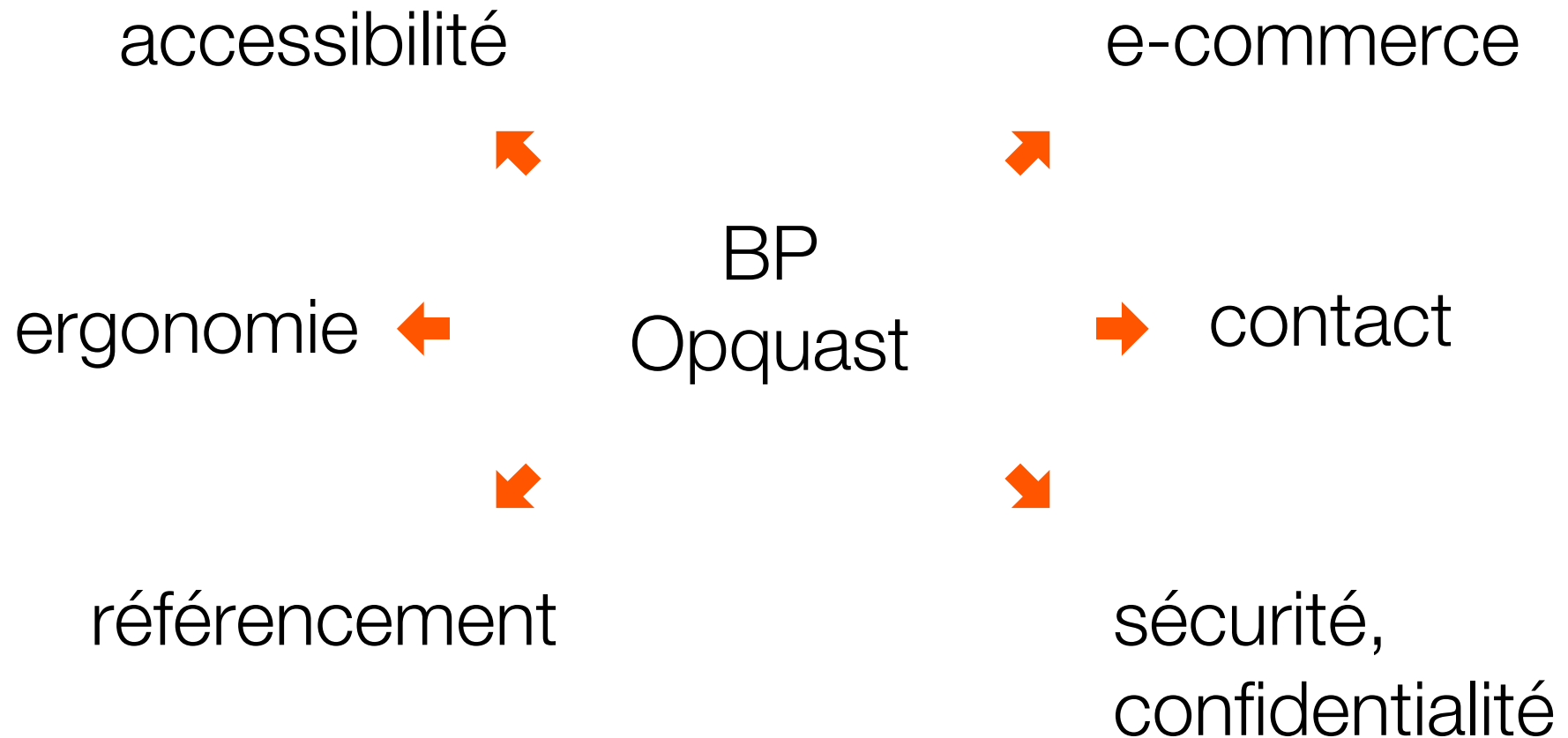
